Students from any university in Argentina studying Physics, Mathematics or Engineering are eligible candidates. After two years of courses in the Department of Atmospheric and Ocean Sciences they will receive their degree

A degree in only two years ??? Yesss and we have been working so that the first course they take is through

Distance Learning!
