The 8th meeting of the VLab Management Group (VLMG), kindly hosted by the Caribbean Meteorological Organization (CMO) and the Caribbean Institute for Meteorology and Hydrology (Barbados), in Bridgetown, Barbados, from 9 to 13 May 2016, offers a key opportunity to discuss how the new VLab strategy 2015-2019 can be effectively put into practice to address satellite-related capacity development of Members in all WMO Regions and official languages.

A new generation of meteorological satellites is being put in service over the coming 5 years, providing great opportunities to satellite meteorology and related applications, but, due to novel data types and larger data volumes, also posing unprecedented challenges to effective use by the WMO community.

The global VLab training activity is a unique tool to address these and other capacity development challenges, as recognized in the new VLab strategy. I take the opportunity to remind you of the online event week on Preparing for the Next Generation of Satellites, held in November 2015, which saw participation by all key CGMS operators and had excellent participation by users.
