


WMO Centre of excellence for Training in Meteorological Satellite Applications- Muscat

COE-Muscat was founded in January 2006 within WMO Region II under the sponsor of Eumetsat. The aim s of the centre are:


- 1. Addressing the training needs in remote sensing applications for Middle East Countries
